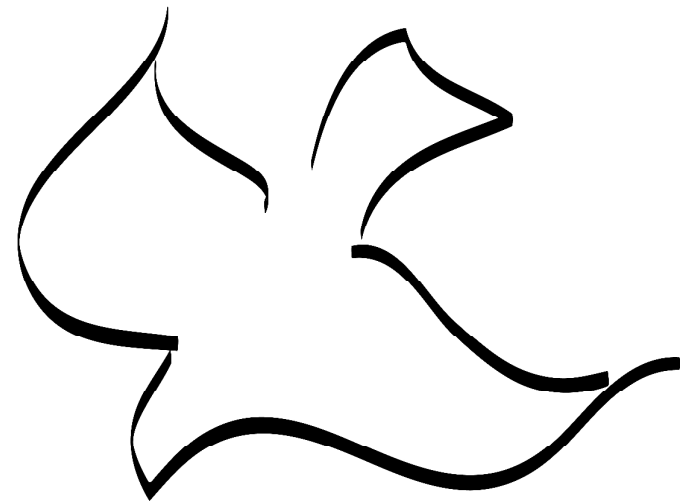

The Rev **Al Reimers** is receiving his ANIC license from Bishop Charlie on the 14<sup>th</sup> as well. Be sure to congratulate him.

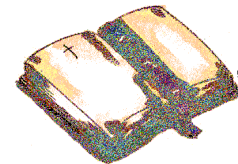
We have a box at the back of the church for contributions to the **Food Bank and to the CDC**. Please try to remember this important cause when you come to church on Sunday.
