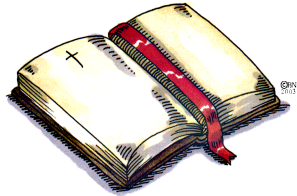


Next week at St. James:

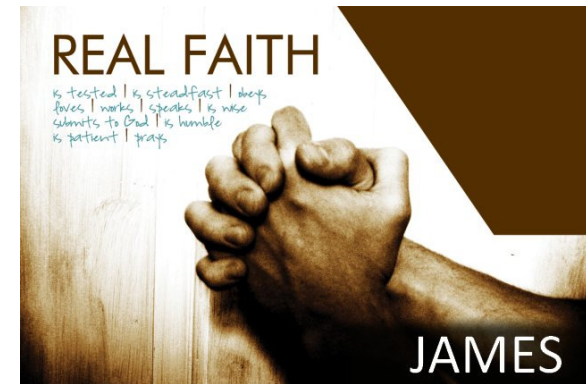

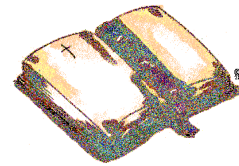
