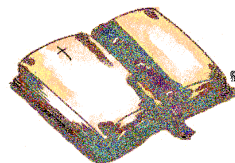
What a wonderful evening we had last night. Thanks to everyone who participated, and a extra big thank you to everyone who organized and worked to put it together.
