Next Sunday is Remembrance Sunday. We will have a table available for you to display pictures of your loved ones who have been a part of defending freedom and peace in the world.

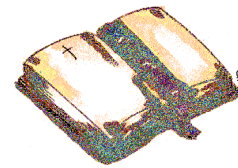


Pentecost 21
